<p>If we keep the default installation directory, in the start menu we have the shortcuts: GRASS GIS 7.4.4 and QGIS desktop 3.4.4 with GRASS 7.4.4.</p> <p>If we change the installation directory we have in addition: Osgeo4w shell, QT designer, SAGA GIS (2.3.2) and setup.</p> <p>Why this difference? The additional shortcuts are very useful, in particular setup allows you to add missing libraries later on in the standalone version (like openCV).</p> <p>It's not just a case of shortcuts. It seems that if you change the default installation directory there is an additional post processing.</p>
