<p>Using the Hidden Coverage Layer option in Composer Atlas, has no effect when exporting Atlas as Images.</p> <p>Exporting Atlas as PDF or SVG, the coverage layer is hidden correctly.</p> <p>The Preview Atlas also works as expected, selecting or deselecting Hidden Coverage Layer option.</p> <p>So, the problem only occurs exporting Atlas as Images (in any format, jpg, png, tiff, ...).</p> <p>Tested in Windows.</p> <p>It works ok in 2.18.28, so it is a regression in QGIS 3 (3.4.4 and master).</p>
