<p>Using Layer Properties > Style > Save Style, I save a style for a geopackage layer, and I enter the 'Name' and a slightly longer text for the 'Description'. Then, I go into the Load Style dialog for a layer in the same geopackage.</p> <p>In the 'Styles related to the layer' table list, the 'Name' text and the 'Description' text are both correctly displaying what I entered.</p> <p>However, in the 'Other styles on the database' table list, the 'Description' column is showing the same text as in the 'Name' column. It should display the text that I entered for 'Description' when I saved the styles.</p> <p>(I do not know what category to make this report - maybe 'Forms'?)</p>
