Description It would be nice to be able to create shortcuts that combine mouse click and modifier key like ArcMap allows in some situations. I forgot to add F6 as a default shortcut to Open Attribute Table, thanks for pointing this out.
As for Ctrl + J, I'm on QGIS 3.4.1 and it works without any problem (I don't think it's something new).

QGIS allows to customize keyboard shortcuts and that's great, however, it doesn't allow a combination of a modifier key (Shift, Ctrl or Alt) and a mouse click, that's what I'm looking for. This kind of shortcut needs to be contextual as it depends on which element the mouse click event is recorded (on a layer name or on the row number of an Attribute Table in my exemples).
