<b>Description</b>		
To reproduce:		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- load an nc file</li><li>- make sure the Layer Styling panel is visible in QGIS</li><li>- after loading the nc file (and seeing it in default Color ramp)</li><li>- use the little dropdown arrow to the right to change it to another (predefined) ramp</li><li>- the classes/colors do NOT change</li></ul>		
BUT: if you click the 'Load' button once, the new color ramp is used		
AND after that changing of the color ramp KEEPS working as expected
