<p>Algorithms in the modeller don't have the collapsible panel on the right with the help which is visible when we execute the algorithm from the toolbox.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- This is a problem for algorithms which are "modeller only". We have no way to read the documentation for these algorithms.</li><li>- It's not convenient to not have the documentation in the same window when we are in the modeller.</li><li>- There is a button at the bottom left corner of the dialog for the online help. But the help button leads to a default qgis.org page for algorithms which are not in core (plugins for instance).</li></ul> <p>It would be better to have the same dialog between the toolbox and the modeller with the help panel on the right.</p>
