<p>For some numeric fields thousand separator are desirable (e.g. for large numbers), but for other numeric fields, they are not desirable (e.g. a zipcode).</p> <p>We would like to be able to configure per field/widget in QGIS desktop if the thousand separator is displayed (or alternatively be able to provide a format for a number) - e.g. like in https://www.postgresql.org/docs/11/functions-formatting.html</p> <p>The same formatting should be used on both Desktop and server in GetFeatureInfo queries.</p> <p>We want to avoid GetFeatureInfo results like in the screenshot attached.</p>
