<p>Many https services use email address as a user name. This cannot be used directly in QGIS as the "@" character not properly encoded when sent to the server</p> <p>For example the user name "dave@phased.co.uk" must be entered as "dave%40phased.co.uk" to work. This is not very user friendly.</p> <p>I suspect the same is true for the password field.</p>
