<p>On QGIS 2.18 and 3.6, opening the Print Composer and saving with it to a JPEG with Worldfile, the JPW is generated as here:</p> <p>0.076330820580</p> <p>0.000000000000</p> <p>0.000000000000</p> <p>-0.076336884245</p> <p>666772.714626354864</p> <p>5102079.949439144693</p> <p>There are empty lines between numbers and two empty lines after the last number.</p> <p>They should not be there. For this reason, AutoCAD cannot recognize these worldfiles.</p>
