Testcase		
1. Create a new connection to [[PostGIS]] database with all fields filled and save it		
2. Create another connection with same name and fill fields with another data		
3. Save second connection		
First connection will be overwritten without any warnings and prompts. Same problem with WMS connections - there is no overwrite prompt or warning message.
