Description <p>Unlike GRASS, QGIS does not yet offer relevant color tables in "Raster Layer Properties" - "Symbology". When showing [[GeoTIFFs]] etc without integrated color table (typical case), the map appears all grey. Having a set of predefined color tables would be a reasonable usability improvement.</p> <p>The GRASS color tables are simple ASCII files: https://trac.osgeo.org/grass/browser/grass/branches/releasebranch_6_4/lib/gis/colors and may be used in QGIS as well.</p>
