QGIS 1.4.0 sends no VERSION for WMS <code>[[GetCapabilities]]</code> . When it gets version 1.1.1 capabilities back, it still does the <code>[[GetMap]]</code> with <code>VERSION=1.3.0</code> . This breaks servers that don't work with 1.3.0.
