<p>1) Identify features window:</p> <p>1a) The default column dimensions in the identify features window are very small by default</p> <p>1b) The adjustment in column sizes doesn't persist when the window is opened again</p> <p>2) It would be good if the Layer Properties window opened in the same tab that was used before. I think this is the way QGIS behaved in version 0.7</p> <p>3) I prefer the toolbar button (upper right on the window title bar) has a behavior consistent with OSX: clicking on the button disables/enables the toolbar altogether. The way it currently works (switching between one set of toolbars or another) is interesting, but I think it's valuable to be consistent with the rest of the OS.</p> <p>Thanks, AC</p>
