Environment: few .tab and .shp line layers; polygon .shp layer in edition	
Behaviour: adding attribute values in the pop-up window after edition causes disappearing .tab layers from the map canvas. shp layer stays displayed. Only zoom to a layer brings .tab layers back, no other navigation functions do so, nor saving the editing layer.	
Adding attribute values in the Attribute table works ok (may go to other row), unless you want to do something on map canvas - then the layers disappear from the map canvas.
