<p>Using the Style Manager, I am trying to create a stop in a gradient color ramp. With Multiple stops selected, I click the Add stop button and the color dialog appears where I then select the color and click OK. The Offset of the stop dialog appears. Whether I click Cancel or OK, QGIS no longer responds to mouse clicks when the dialog closes. At this point I must kill QGIS.</p> <p>Tested with QGIS dev builds r13385 and r13519 from [[KyngChaos]] using OS X 10.6.3.</p>

When either the Cancel or OK button in the Offset of the stop dialog is clicked, CPU usage jumps to 100% of 1 core and memory usage starts to climb.
