<b>Description</b>	
<p>In some situations, user wants to avoid labeling for very small features even if there are no label position conflicts.</p> <p>The attached patch adds the capability of suppressing labeling for small features. The user specifies a minimum size in mm and <code>pallabeling.cpp</code> checks the length / area of a features vs. the minimum value (or the square of the minimum value for polygons) before sending the label to <code>pal</code>.</p>
