<p>Raster layers are distorted (wrong scaled?) in the map composer. At the southern and eastern edge there is some unfilled space left and you can see the covered vector layers.</p> <p>If the raster map has some coordinate grid you can see some difference between the grid from QGIS and the raster grid (getting bigger towards east and south).</p>
