Load a shapefile into qgis from CLI - at it's startup, eg.:

qgis tmp/gh_fragmet/parcels_15_2zl_GH_selekt_anon/parcels_15_2zl_GH_selekt_anon.shp ERROR 4: @/home/shoofi/tmp/gh_fragmet/parcels_15_2zl_GH_selekt_anon/parcels_15_2zl_GH_selekt_anon.shp' not recognised as a supported file format.
