<p>Today I got a notice that my Plugins Starter Plugin may be upgraded from 0.3.1 to 0.3.2. So I go to <b>Plugins &gt; Fetch Python Plugins</b>, select <b>Plugins Starter Plugin</b>, and hit <b>Upgrade plugin</b>.</p> <p>Even though I get a dialog saying <b>Plugin reinstalled correctly</b>, it never actually upgrades. The <b>QGIS Python Plugin Installer</b> dialog still shows <b>0.3.1 -&gt; 0.3.2</b> for that plugin's version.</p> <p>Even if I close qgis and restart, I get the same problem. I even tried running qgis as an administrator (right-click on its Start Menu icon and select <b>Run as administrator</b>), and that doesn't fix it.</p>
