<p>Import a vector layer and display the map in full extent: the map occupies all the view window (see img1).</p> <p>Close the project.</p> <p>Re-open it: the map is not displayed completely (see img2).</p> <p>If I then "zoom to layer extent", the complete map is displayed but using only a small part to the window (see img3). "Zoom to full extent" doesn't have any effect.</p> <p>Version française sur Ubuntu 10.04</p>
