this is still true for QGIS 2.13 master !

When you use the instructions indicated in the INSTALL file and try to make uninstall just after ccmake ..., you've got the following:

CMake Error at cmake\_uninstall.cmake:2 (MESSAGE):

Cannot find install manifest:

"/home/medspx/projects/QGIS/QGIS/build-test/install\_manifest.txt"

So you can't make a build directory, configure CMake with ccmake and make uninstall without having made at least one make install. But it seems to be a <u>CMake problem</u> and not a QGIS one. Should we delete this bug or try to find a workaround ?
