| <p>Currently one WMS Provider gets invoked as part of <code>[[QgsServerSourceSelect]]</code> and a second is invoked in <code>[[QgsRasterLayer]]</code> once a WMS server is selected.</p> <p>Unfortunately this means the WMS Capabilities gets downloaded twice, which is wasteful and shows up as a small delay (unexplained in the GUI) once the user selected their layers from the WMS server.</p> <p>This is not a bug, therefore can slip the 0.8 release.</p> | | |
