<p>New Feature: show Raster Band number on Layer Panel entries.</p> <p>In QGIS 1.7 it is very hard to figure out the Raster data one is working on, specially if the project contains many Raster Bands and/or layers or is shared with someone else.</p> <p>IMHO, it should simply be tagged along the existing "Display classification attribute names in legend", ie, if layer is Raster, show "Band 3" or so accordingly.</p> <p>It should also be on the "Metadata" tab of "Layer Properties" and other places too.</p>
