I'm using qgis 1.7.0 Wroclaw</p> <p>Steps to reproduce:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1.- Open the remote server in nautilus (the file explorer of ubuntu)2.- Double click on the shp file to open it in qgis3.- Open the attribute table and begin edition4.- Change some value5.- Close edition <p>All the rows of the dbf get NULL values, not only those which you edited.</p> <p>PD: This is my first bug report on qgis. Please tell me if anything else is needed or something is wrong.</p>
