I'm using qgis 1.7.0 Wrocław</p> <p>Steps to reproduce:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1.- Open the remote server in nautilus (the file explorer of ubuntu)</li><li>2.- Double click on the shp file to open it in qgis</li><li>3.- Open the attribute table and begin edition</li><li>4.- Change some value</li><li>5.- Close edition</li></ol> <p>All the rows of the dbf get NULL values, not only those which you edited.</p> <p>PD: This is my first bug report on qgis. Please tell me if anything else is needed or something is wrong.</p>
