<p>QGIS crashes when exiting if some C++ plugin is active - noticed this with the GeoReferencer and the Spatial Query. Perhaps others do this, too -- haven't tested. This is on Windows 7, I don't know about other platforms.</p> <p>For the GeoReferencer this happens whether docked or not, and even with no layers loaded. If GeoReferencer is closed before exiting QGIS, no problem.</p>
