Each map shows different layers, achieved by using the 'lock layers for map items' checkbox.</p> <p>When I add a new layer to my project, the composer maps forget what layers are supposed to be locked for that window and turn some layers off.</p> <p>I then have to go through each composer and re tell it which layers to lock.</p> <p>Windows XP and QGIS 1.8 (67df2e) OSGEO4W.</p>
