<p>The dialogues for each gdaltool display the command to be run at the bottom.</p> <p>It would be good if it was possible to manually edit the command. e.g. one option which might be used commonly is the -ot option to specify the data type of the bands in the output image (Byte/Int16/UInt16/UInt32/Int32/Float32/Float64/CInt16/CInt32/CFloat32/CFloat64).</p> <p>If it was possible to manually edit the command, the "Creation options" feature could probably be removed (if the users know what to insert as a creation option it is probably safe to assume they know to type -co to add creation options).</p> <p>If it is too complicated to allow the user to manually edit the command, there could simply be a line edit widget for typing "additional options".</p>
