<p>(N.B. I thought a bug like this was reported a long time ago, but I can't find it).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Open an attribute table</li><li>- Click the edit button</li><li>- Add or delete a column</li><li>- Click the edit button, and then click to Discard changes.</li></ul> <p>The attribute table will be refreshed as it should be (i.e. the column will disappear or reappear again).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Open an attribute table</li><li>- Click the edit button</li><li>- Add or delete a feature, or change one of its attributes</li><li>- Click the edit button, and then click to Discard changes.</li></ul> <p>The attribute table will not be refreshed as it should be. To refresh it you need to close and reopen it.</p>
