<p>The "Only show plugins from the official repository" option in the "Options" tab of the plugin_installer duplicates functionality already available as a filter in the "Plugins" tab. This is very confusing as you <i>think</i> you're seeing plugins from "all repositories" (the filter says) but instead you're restricted to official repository only due to that option checked in a tab you don't see in front of you.</p> <p>This confusion made me waste a couple of hours trying to debug issue #4621</p> <p>It'd be nice to see this fixed in 1.7 branch too.</p> <p>I'm missing Target version 1.7.4 here :)</p> <p>Maybe easier to add a Target version 1.7 ?</p>
