<p>When I right-click on a layer, select <b>Properties</b>, then go to the <b>Metadata</b> tab, there is a line in the <b>General</b> section titled <b>The number of features in this layer</b>. I've often found this number to be drastically lower than the number of rows in my PostGIS tables.</p> <p>This number seems to grow and shrink predictably when I zoom in and out, so I think this count might actually be the number of items in view, not the number of items in the layer.</p>
