<p>Qgis (I'm using version 1.9.90-Alpha apt-get updated from nightly build this morning) crashes in this situation: I choose Raster Calculator (from main menu Raster->Raster Calculator) and make no selections or calculations. I just press OK button and Qgis kicks me out to the operating system.</p>
