<p>If I do anything that causes the Identify Results dock to appear, such as clicking on the Identify Features or Select single feature buttons, the entire canvas redraws. Seems like a pointless redraw since the dock, in my case, does not change the canvas dimensions when it opens; it just encroaches on the Layers dock.</p> <p>If I close the Identify Results dock, there's no redraw, but it happens again if I click on one of those buttons.</p>
