<p>When you use "Save as Image" dialog to export your map as an image file, text annotations are not incorporated in the export file. I tried many different file formats (tif/jpg/png) with no change at all. The bug is still here even if you have saved your project (annotations are saved in the project file).</p> <p>I provide two files for this bug report:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- first is a screen cap of the map with text annotations</li><li>- second is an export file where you can see that there is no annotation at all.</li></ul> <p>Cheers !</p>
