<p>I create a new composer, then click on the "Add arrow" button and then click on the blank space.</p> <p>This gives me a piddly little arrow. So I mouse over one of the corner boxes and drag and see a nice satisfying bounding box which implies my arrow is about to get bigger. I release the mouse button and... the arrow moves to the new location but doesn't get any bigger.</p>
