<p>When trying to load WCS layers from the server, I always get the "The layer is not a valid layer and can not be added to the map" message. Also, when selecting the layer from the list, the information is that there are 0 CRS available.</p> <p>The authentication seems to work and the layer list is shown accordingly.</p> <p>The server I'm using is Geoserver 2.1.3 and can be accessed here: http://geoserver-dev-1.irradiare.com:8080/geoserver/</p> <p>Apparently it works with gvsig.</p>
