<b>Description</b>		
<p>To arrange info in a tabular look, it is common to use tab-stops. Inside the Print Composer, when adding a label it is possible to layout the text with tabs (In Item Properties / Label )</p> <p>Nevertheless, this layout is not reflected inside the actual label.</p> <p>E.g.</p> <p>I want to add some information like:</p> <div><p>Source: OpenStreetMap</p><p>Date: 27.7.2012</p><p>Author: Matthias Kuhn</p></div> <p>I want the values to be in the same horizontal offset, but they are not aligned.</p> <p>Is this already possible (maybe with another tool than label)?</p> <p>If not:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Different fonts and their spacings could be a problem. So maybe it would be necessary to add a ruler to control tab-stops to the label text field?</li><li>- With an additional table tool this could be achieved as well</li></ul>
