| <p>if QGIS is not running, and you double-click/drag-n-drop/open-with a file (ie a shapefile), this normally starts up QGIS and adds the file to the new project that is always created on startup. Now, the file is added to a new project, then the project is closed to create another new project. This triggers the save/cancel dialog - if you Don't Save or Save, the project is closed and a new empty project created, if you Cancel, the original project with the opened file remains.</p> <p>Kinda sounds like the order of startup operations changed, so the usual new empty project is created after the opened files are processed?</p> <p>Works correctly in 1.8.</p> |                                     |
