<p>In Styling -&gt; Categorized I have labels such as:</p> <p>alpha Beta charlie Delta</p> <p>If I set it to sort, I would expect it to sort in that order ascending. However QGIS seems to be case sensitive when sorting, so I get:</p> <p>alpha charlie Beta Delta</p> <p>Aren't sorts normally case insensitive? That's certainly what I'd expect as a regular user.</p>
