<p>The option "decimal point" only affects the fields "lat" and "long" and it will fail if the user try to add a csv data sheet with numerical fields other than ".". So these columns are imported as text or the plugin aborts.</p> <p>Using comma as decimal point and semicolon to separate columns is the standard in MS Excel and LibreOffcie Calc for some Latin languages (e.g. Portuguese).</p> <p>Thanks in advance.</p> <p>Qgis 1.8.0 (Ubuntu 64 and Win7 64).</p>
