<p>Hi,</p> <p>somewhat related to #6729, but not exactly. When moving a label with 'data defined labeling', no warning is raised when trying to close project, or open a new one (or closing QGIS).</p> <p>It works OK if moving editing the real geometry. Some signal seems to miss when using labeling toolbar though.</p> <p>Quite annoying since users here lost some work several times</p> <p>Régis</p>
