### Forms with input fields and multiple controls shouldn't bind enter key to OK button

<b>Description</b>  Currently most of QGIS forms have binded enter key event to OK button. It might cause unwanted side effect if form has an input field and OK button is not the only possible action to take. Examples: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Create new Shapefile has "attribute name" input field. If user presses enter key after typing in attribute name, whole dialog gets closed instead of just adding a new attribute and the specified attribute is NOT created;</li><li>- Project properties -&gt; CRS has a filter dialog. Pressing enter closes dialog instead of just searching.</li></ul>
