| <p>How it happened:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Open DBManager, select a topology schema, select Topology Viewer- Issue a SELECT DropTopology(<topology_name>) from an external monitor (psql)- Verify that the command hangs, waiting on a lock- Remove the whole topology viewer layer group from the registry <p>What happens:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- The DropTopology select is still waiting for the lock to be removed <p>Expected behavior:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- QGIS releases the lock when the layer is removed, and DropTopology command can complete <p>NOTE: I had to close QGIS in order for the command to complete.</p> <p>This happened with qgis as of head = commit:314d144</p> | | |
