| <p>Observed in both: 1.8 and Master. With equal intervals, the same behaviour is observed in both: old and new symbologies. Pretty Breaks are only present in the new one.</p> <p>In Master, The Equal Intervals generates downward classes, from minimal value down to 0. In 1,8, it generates empty classes (from 0 to 0). The Pretty Breaks don't generate anything in both versions.</p> <p>The same values work fine in base (non-joined) fields.</p> | | |
