HKEY_USERS\\S-1-5-21-[many numbers here]-1000\\Software\\QuantumGIS\\QGIS\\UI 3. recentProjections - add user code, for example 100010 4. recentProjectionsAuthId - add the same user code, USER:100010 5. Run QGIS 6. Try to change CRS in Settings\\Project properties -> QGIS will crash.</p> <p>This happens a lot, when user uninstalls QGIS where he had custom CRSes, but registry doesn't get cleared appropriately and refs for these codes remain.</p> <p>QGIS should not trip over those codes if it finds them, just skip them.</p> | |
