<p>This apparently existed within a single layer before, but isn't present on my version. For those of us who have rivers with 1000-odd edge points running through our study area, analysis feature after feature use river edges when they meet them, and usually they have to be in other layers.</p> <p>Could I suggest: select a feature in any layer, then edit same or another layer: draw freehand around the region where the edited layer feature is to match the selected feature, hit return to confirm?</p> <p>It'd save me hour upon hour in my project here in Ottawa!</p>
