<p>When using the "Simplify geometries" tool, the text in the Warning dialog box comes up with extra spaces (see attached screenshot), as below :</p> <p>"Currently QGIS doesn't allow simultaneous access from {30+ extra spaces} different threads to the same datasource. Make sure your layer's {30+ extra spaces} attribute tables are closed. Continue?"</p> <p>I'm using v1.9 build 253 (QGIS code revision 404d89f).</p>
