<b>Description</b>  It would be a great feature to be able to export the print composer page to an Inkscape SVG, so that every Qgis layer can be saved as inkscape layer, making easier the post processing in inkscape. As of today only if a Qgis layer uses a single symbol then all objects of the layer are grouped in SVG, and is easy to move them to a inkscape layer. But if the layer uses categorized or rule based symbology, then the objects are grouped in a random way. the only workaround I found is exporting every layer as single svgs, then import them on a single inkscape SVG. A time consuming task that could be done automatically by qgis!
