<p>On Windows 7, it is normative for QGIS to default to your own documents directory (C:\Users\username\Documents) when you are saving something for the first time. This version suggested saving to the root of my C drive instead.</p> <p>I am not sure which one it is, but I believe there is some environment variable you access to see what the current user's documents directory is.</p> <p>I am on 1.9 07ea0aa.</p>
