<p>The attribute table should have a selection of tools which all for copying the data from the selected rows.</p> <p>These could be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Copy attribute values- Copy attribute name and value <p>There would work well in a right click and a toolbar button.</p> <p>Some layers do not allow editing so these should work when not in edit mode, much like the info tool does.</p>

- Add a context menu entry to the column headers with a shortcut action to copy just that single column (with header)
- Add entries "copy" and "advanced copy" to the table context menu
